In order to be able to score the competition entries, a minimum of four (4) teams or competitors (for solo disciplines) is required. If the minimum number will not be accomplished, no German champion will be determined in the regarding competition category. However, at the request of the contestants, it can be arranged to hold the discipline in question nonetheless, so that the results can be used as qualification norm for international competitions.

Objectives

- ascertainment of the German champion and standings of the competitors in each of the mentioned disciplines
- knowledge acquisition concerning the qualification level and proficiency in Germany
- support of competitive sports and juniors
- popularization of indoor skydiving and skydiving in the Federal Republic of Germany, i.a. among spectators, press, radio and TV
- strengthening of the indoor and outdoor skydiving community
- achieving new records
- training and further education of judges



Preliminary note

The main purpose of the event is to determine the German champions in each discipline in due consideration of the concepts and standing orders of the DFV / DaeC and the FAI. The event also intends to popularize the attractiveness of in- and outdoor skydiving to the broad public and to promote the further development of that sport. Another purpose is to support young talents and facilitate the access of the population to indoor skydiving.

In accordance with the competition regulations of the BKF (Federal Commission Skydiving) for German skydiving championships 2024 version 11.

Protest procedures

In accordance with the regulations of the FAI/ISC Sporting Code, Section 5.

Rules and number of competition rounds

The rules are based on the current FAI/ISC sporting code, general section, section 5 – skydiving, the WDM *Wettbewerbsordnung Deutsche Meisterschaften* 2024 Version 11 (if applicable for indoor skydiving) and the competition rules of each discipline with the respective applying programs.

- **4er IFS** **10** rounds at 35 seconds working time per round ([live judging](#))
- **8er IFS** **10** rounds at 50 seconds working time per round ([live judging](#))
- **4er IVFS** **10** rounds at 35 seconds working time per round
- **Dynamic 2-Way Open** qualification + battle I speed rounds and free routine
- **Dynamic 2-Way Intermed.** qualification + battle I speed rounds only
- **Dynamic 4-Way** qualification + battle I speed rounds only
- **Dynamic Solo-Speed** qualification + battle
- **Indoor Solo Freestyle Open** rounds compulsory, 3 rounds free routines
- **Indoor Solo Freestyle Intermediate** rounds compulsory, 3 rounds free routines
- **Indoor Para Skydiving** 2 rounds warm-up, 3 rounds qualification, semi-final, final



Participation requirements

At registration for the IDM 2026, all participants have to provide the valid membership at the DFV (Deutscher Fallschirmsportverband *German Skydiving Association*) or the DAeC (Deutscher Aero-Club *German Aero Club*). The proof of membership has to be provided by submitting the regarding membership number (DFV or DAeC-Landesverband *regional association*). That regulation does not apply to non-German competitors or teams which participate outside of the scoring for the German Championship.

If membership is required, a membership form can be found in the download area of the DFV website: www.dfv.aero/Service/Downloads.

Meanwhile it is each competitor's responsibility to dress according to the discipline and the specific requirements of indoor skydiving. The competition equipment will be checked by the event organizer. The minimum equipment of each participant consists of a flying suit, shoes, helmet (without any camera mounts), hearing protection and googles (if applicable); appropriate protection is welcome.

By signing up, all participants accept the terms and conditions of the IDM 2026. Non-Compliance of the rules can lead to exclusion from the competition. Each participant declares individually to follow the organizer's instructions in connection with the competition.

The participation for each competitor is limited to maximum two (2) disciplines with maximum two (2) sub-disciplines with the limitation to one (1) class only. Due to the identical target group, IVFS will be counted to the artistic disciplines. Participation in three (3) contemporaneous sub-disciplines is not permitted at this competition.

Example: discipline **FS** / sub-disciple **FS4/FS8** / class **Open, Female, Intermediate etc.**

The event organizer reserves the right to execute countermeasures.

Doping controls at the IDM

Due to the actual requirements of the national Anti Doping Agency (NADA) and the DOSB (Deutscher Olympischer Sportbund *German Olympic Association*) doping controls will also be carried out at the German Nationals in Indoor Skydiving. In principle, **all competitors** might be subject to a doping control.

It is to be expected that five (5) probands will be selected from the field of participants. The current anti-doping rules and behavioral measures can be found on the DFV website (<https://www.dfv.aero/Sicher/Medizin+Gesundheit/Doping>) or they can be requested as pdf file from the DFV office.

If you are taking medication indicated by NADA/WADA due to medical reasons, your intake has to be reported by the TUE (therapeutic use exemption) form before the start of the competition. The regarding forms can be requested at the DFV office or directly at NADA.

Video and photo rights

When registering for the competition, all participants agree to transfer their rights to their own image, especially regarding the video and photo footage taken during the IDM 2026, to the organizer and the competition organization for the duration of the competition and beyond, including the usage in the context of press work and public relations. The necessary consent will be requested on the registration form.

Late registrations are only possible with approval and by agreement of the organizer (late registration fee +€ 15,00 per person).

The registration fee includes:

- organisation fee IDM 2026
- the participation at the German Nationals in Indoor Skydiving 2026 including the flight time for the registered discipline
- 2 min speed settings
- one goodie bag for each participant
- dinner buffet on Saturday, 14 March 2026 at the closing party

Cancellation of participation

If a team or a competitor does not compete after the registration has been submitted, a reimbursement for flight time and speed settings (amount depends on the respective discipline) will be carried out, the share for organization fee, goodie bag and dinner buffet is non-refundable.

In case of cancellation before 31 January 2026, 100 % of the registration fee will be reimbursed.

Medals, certificates, cups

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place of each scored discipline will receive medals. Each participant will receive a certificate of attendance.
